Initial Consultation (Traditional Diagnosis)

During your first consultation I will enquire about your general health and wellbeing and take a medical history. Your blood pressure will be taken and I will feel your pulse usually on both wrists. You will be asked to undress down to your under clothes so that the temperature of your body can be guaged and there will be a non-invasive abdominal examination. This will be done with utmost care and blankets will be provided for your dignity and comfort. I will also ask to look at your tongue. It is best to wear casual, loose clothing. You will be kept informed of any procedure and you may withdraw your consent at any time.

Treatment

Acupuncture involves the insertion of fine needles in to the body. I only use disposable needles which are pre-sterilised and used once only. You may be required to loosen or remove articles of clothing in order to gain access to certain points. It is best not to eat too soon before or after a treatment and on occasion you may feel sleepy afterwards. If this is the case it may be best to allow some time to rest a while.

Moxibustion

On occasion I will wish to use moxa. This is a dried herb made from mugwort. This is a common plant and has been used for thousands of years in traditional East Asian medicine. Small cones of it are placed on acupuncture points and lit with a taper. They gently burn down to introduce warmth to the body and are removed when you feel the heat.

Cupping

It is occasionally beneficial to apply suction cups to the surface of the body over certain acupuncture points. This form of treatment can be especially beneficial for muscular skeletal aches and pains and an area of the body that this is most commonly used on is the back.

Confidentiality

All information that I keep about you and your treatments is kept in the strictest confidence. I work in compliance with the guidelines given by the British Acupuncture Council (BAcC) - the professional governing body in the UK. Possible exceptions to confidentiality would be if I was compelled to disclose information in a court of law or if I thought you were in danger of causing harm to yourself or others.
